Our Legislative

- The 20 pieces of legislation assists the agency in the adaptive challenge of being "brokers of knowledge and conveners of strategic conversations".
- Each piece of legislation are language updates to allow us greater flexibility.



Structural Redesign Drivers

- Simplify design.
- Live within the current realities of shrinking financial resources.
- Keep our focus on the main thing: Helping church leaders make disciples.



Division on Ministries with Young People (DMYP)

- One piece of legislation allows for greater flexibility to serve young people and renames it The Young People's Connectional Network.
- The current size of the DMYP (50+) would be reduced to 18 in the YPCN, the current size of the DMYP Executive Table.



Division on Ministries with Young People (DMYP)

 Global representation and diversity of representatives of the YPCN would be maintained through an updated selection process.



Division on Ministries with Young People (DMYP)

- Global Convocation (every 4 years) would continue, with a focus on leadership development, discipleship, and networking.
 - The legislation removes the requirement for a legislative body as a part of this event.
 - The legislation does not prohibit legislation from the Global Convocation, but it no longer requires it.
